

Initially, the B.P.H.E. Society had Ahmednagar College, the only institution under its control. In those days, the Management Courses namely, DBM, MMS and MSW were the departments of Ahmednagar College. In 1990, the BPHE Society created Institute of Management Studies, Career Development & Research and merged DBM and MMS into it and later, added, MCM, DCM, MPM, Office Management, MBA, MCA etc courses offered atthe Institute duly approved by the then University of Pune and AIACTE. Mumbai. Dr SB Kolte was appointed as the Director of the Institute. Similarly, the BPHE Society created another Institute of Social Work & Research merging the Centre for Studies in Rural MSW. MMR courses which was Development. approved by the then University of Pune. Prof RM Munshi was its first Director.

Now, the BPHE Society as per its Constitution is having three full fledged Units with Christian Minority Status from the Govt of Maharashtra as well as from the All India Assosciation for Christian Higher Education, New Delhi.

The Centre for Studies in Rural Development was established by the BPHE in 1961 with a long term goal to sensitize the academic community to the needs of Society and to integrate the educational process with that of the economic, social and political processes of the country. This Centre had done enormous work in the

areas of agriculture, farmer club, health and family welfare, women, afforestation, children, poultry, tribal welfare, slum adoption etc. and earned a good name. The NSS is the baby of this Centre.

The BPHE Society is in the possession of Anand Sadan located in the Ahmednagar City. Anand Sadan as an urban extension project is being developed as centre for conducting various community outreach programames of CSRD. Activities at Anand Sadan includes non-formal education in the form of remedial and supplementary coaching to school dropouts and school going children of the neighbourhood, home visits for counselling the parents, Life Skills training for the adolescent and youth, personality development programmes, cultural and sports activities for the children.

Academy of Fine and Performing Arts established by the BPHE Society from the academic year 2016-17. The IMS Videocon Academy of Fine & Performing Arts was discontinued and all its activities were merged into the newly formed Academy by the BPHES. This academy especially conducts diploma/certificate courses in Bharatnatyam and Kathak dance forms.

The BPHE Society is having its property at Mahabaleshwar known as Green Hill, Tree-Top, Cliff etc on lease basis especially for running School of Theology and Social Sciences. This property is inclusive of one Church. The College Campus is also having a Chapel for conducting Sunday Service, Bible Studies, etc especially for Christian staff and students.

FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

The academic year 2018-19 has been eventful for Ahmednagar College with many memorable achievements and accolades. It is an year when many of our students brought laurels to the college in academics by earning positions in the University rankings; our sportspersons shonewith their skills at university and regional levels; our students won prizes at state and national level cultural competitions; our faculty also showed their merit in becoming nominated or elected to various University bodies and being invited as resource persons at national level conferences and seminars.

In fact, the year marked a major step ahead for the College as we organised an International Conference after many years. We also conducted two hugely successful National level conferences - one by English department and the other by IQAC - and one state-level seminar by the Physics department.

As the BPHE Society is celebrating its Golden Jubilee, it is a historical occasion. Marking the occasion, the College has executed several special activities.


