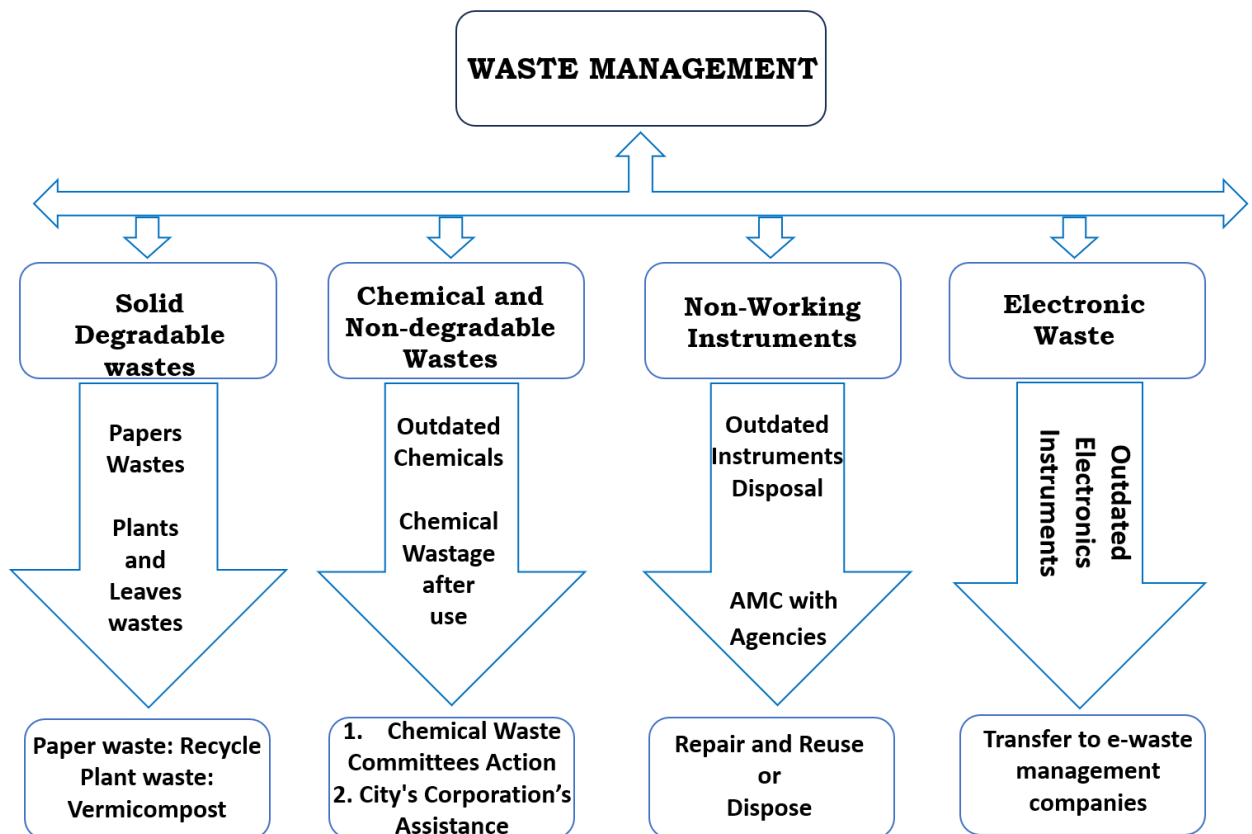

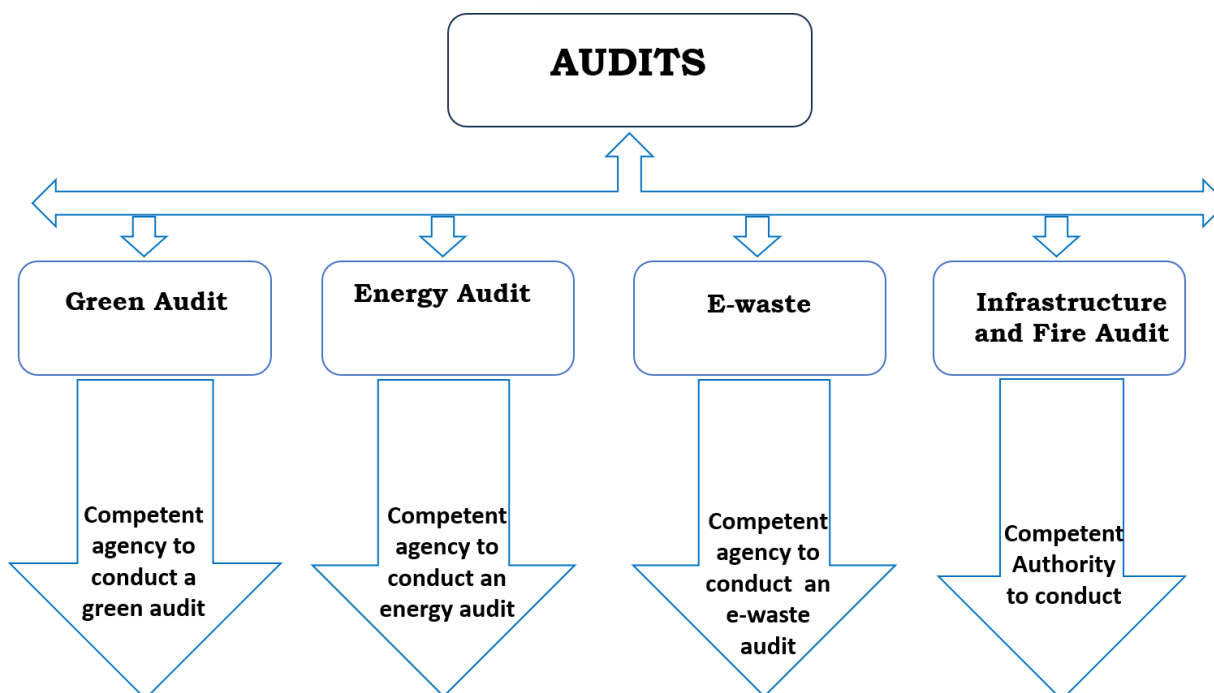

GREEN CAMPUS POLICY DOCUMENT

Ahmednagar College is dedicated to safeguarding and preserving the environment, undertaking conscientious efforts for the benefit of environmental protection and conservation. Our environmentally friendly initiatives specifically address the management and proper handling of solid waste, chemical waste, and e-waste, incorporating comprehensive management and audit practices. MANAGEMENT

Solid Waste Management: The segregation of solid waste into degradable and non-degradable categories is a key aspect of our approach. The institute will implement a vermicompost project to handle bio-degradable waste, producing vermicompost for use on campus for plantations. Non-degradable waste will be managed in collaboration with the Ahmednagar City Municipal Corporation, for which the College will provide collection bins for both dry and wet waste installed across the entire campus. The Municipal Corporation's vehicles will be instrumental in disposing of non-degradable waste on campus.

Chemical Waste: The responsibility for managing chemical waste generated in laboratories falls under the purview of the chemistry department faculty. A chemical waste committee will be formed to oversee the process.

E-waste: Certified agencies will be engaged for the proper disposal of e-waste on campus through the signing of Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs).

Non-working Instruments: The physics department faculty and relevant experts will assess non-working instruments. Non-repairable instruments will be removed from the stock record,

while repairable ones will be addressed through Annual Maintenance Contracts (AMCs) with different agencies.

AUDIT

Green Audit: A certified competent agency will conduct a green audit of the campus, encompassing green, energy, and water audits. The Green Campus Committee of the college will ensure compliance with any recommendations and oversee all environmental initiatives and activities on campus.

Infrastructure and Fire Audit: Competent authorities will conduct building and fire audits, with a dedicated committee formed to identify and execute infrastructure and fire audit procedures.

All the aforementioned management and audit activities will be carried out on campus. This policy document remains open to adaptation based on new suggestions, protocols, and guidelines provided by competent agencies or authorities.
